Allergies: Does anyone in your family suffer with allergies?

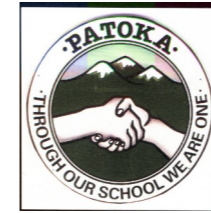

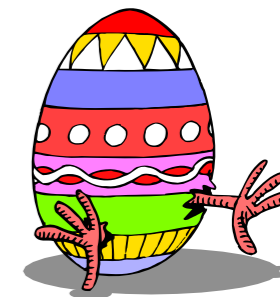
